Gran Cenote

-
- DISTANCE FROM TULUM CENTER: 4 KM (ABOUT 10 MINUTES BY CAR) •
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Entry Fee: \$200 MXN

Opening Hours: 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

What to Bring: Biodegradable sunscreen, snorkeling gear, water shoes

Good for: Families, snorkelers, nature lovers

Special Feature: Crystal-clear waters with caves and plenty of wildlife like turtles



Cenote Escondido

- DISTANCE FROM TULUM CENTER: 4 KM (ABOUT 10 MINUTES BY CAR, NEXT TO CENOTE CRISTAL) ●

Entry Fee: \$150 MXN (often combined with Cenote Cristal)

Opening Hours: 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

What to Bring: Snorkeling gear, water shoes, picnic supplies

Good for: Adventurous swimmers, nature lovers

Special Feature: Hidden in the jungle with clear waters, perfect for diving off small cliffs and exploring the tranquil surroundings.



Cenote Cristal

- DISTANCE FROM TULUM CENTER: 4 KM (ABOUT 10 MINUTES BY CAR) ●

Entry Fee: \$150 MXN

Opening Hours: 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

What to Bring: Snorkeling gear, biodegradable sunscreen, towels

Good for: Families, swimmers, those seeking a calm spot

Special Feature: Open-air cenote surrounded by lush vegetation; easy access for a refreshing swim.



Cenote Calavera

- DISTANCE FROM TULUM CENTER: 3.5 KM (ABOUT 10 MINUTES BY CAR) •

Entry Fee: \$250 MXN

Opening Hours: 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

What to Bring: Snorkeling gear, water shoes, biodegradable sunscreen

Good for: Divers, adventure seekers

Special Feature: Known for its "skull-like" appearance with three holes in the ground, perfect for jumping in or diving.



Cenote Zacil-Ha

● DISTANCE FROM TULUM CENTER: 8 KM (ABOUT 15 MINUTES BY CAR) ●

Entry Fee: \$100 MXN

Opening Hours: 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

What to Bring: Swimsuit, biodegradable sunscreen, towel

Good for: Families, children, swimmers

Special Feature: Small, shallow cenote with crystal-clear water and zip lines; ideal for kids and families looking for a fun day.



Cenote Dos Ojos

- DISTANCE FROM TULUM CENTER: 20 KM (ABOUT 20 MINUTES BY CAR) ●

Entry Fee: \$350 MXN

Opening Hours: 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

What to Bring: Diving or snorkeling gear, biodegradable sunscreen, flashlight for cave exploration

Good for: Snorkeling, cave diving, adventure seekers

Special Feature: One of the most famous cenotes in the Riviera Maya, known for its two interconnected sinkholes, stunning underwater caves, and crystal-clear waters ideal for diving and snorkeling.

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Cenote Casa Tortuga

- DISTANCE FROM TULUM CENTER: 10 KM (ABOUT 15 MINUTES BY CAR) •

Entry Fee: \$300 MXN (includes guided tour of four cenotes)

Opening Hours: 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

What to Bring: Swimsuit, snorkeling gear, biodegradable sunscreen

Good for: Families, groups, those who want a tour experience

Special Feature: A combination of 3 open-air and cave cenotes; the guided tour is great for families and first-time visitors who want to learn more about cenotes.

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Cenote Jaguar

- DISTANCE FROM TULUM CENTER: 16 KM (ABOUT 15 MINUTES BY CAR) •

Entry Fee: \$250 MXN

Opening Hours: 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

What to Bring: Swimsuit, biodegradable sunscreen, water shoes

Good for: Families, adventure seekers, zip-liners

Special Feature: A fun cenote with zip lines, diving platforms, and plenty of space to swim, making it a great choice for families looking for an exciting day.

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Cenote Carwash

• DISTANCE FROM TULUM CENTER: 8 KM (ABOUT 10 MINUTES BY CAR) •

Entry Fee: \$200 MXN

Opening Hours: 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

What to Bring: Snorkeling gear, towels, biodegradable sunscreen

Good for: Snorkeling, beginner divers, families

Special Feature: A popular cenote among locals, it offers clear water and great visibility. Known for its aquatic life, including fish and turtles, it's ideal for both swimmers and snorkelers.

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Cenote El Pit

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- DISTANCE FROM TULUM CENTER: 21 KM (ABOUT 20 MINUTES BY CAR) •
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Entry Fee: \$350 MXN

Opening Hours: 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

What to Bring: Diving gear (for certified divers), flashlight, biodegradable sunscreen

Good for: Advanced divers, cave diving

Special Feature: A deeper cenote that's part of the Dos Ojos system, it offers dramatic vertical cave diving. Known for its eerie beauty, with stalactites, halocline layers, and mesmerizing lighting effects.

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Cenote Sac Actun

- DISTANCE FROM TULUM CENTER: 2.5 KM (ABOUT 30 MINUTES BY CAR) •

Entry Fee: \$450 MXN (includes guided tour)

Opening Hours: 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

What to Bring: Snorkeling gear, water shoes, biodegradable sunscreen

Good for: Snorkeling, cave exploration

Special Feature: Part of the longest underwater cave system in the world, Sac Actun offers a mesmerizing experience with its long tunnels, ancient rock formations, and crystal-clear
